Since we opened, first as Hokkaido Institute of Technology, in Teine Sapporo, in 1967, Hokkaido University of Science has been raising up human resources who lead the development and growth of Hokkaido.

In 2014, we changed our name to Hokkaido University of Science, and currently we have 4 faculties, 13 departments, and 3 graduate schools on the Teine Maeda campus. We are one of the largest universities with about 5,000 students studying on the campus.

Our basic philosophy is to develop “**+Professional** Human Resources” based on the following foundations:

- Fostering “scientific citizens”
- Professional education in line with current needs
- Contribution to the region and its community

We define “**+Professional** Human Resources” as people who have well-balanced fundamental skills, which are universal qualities such as communicating skills, problem-solving abilities, and professional skills in each specialized field our changing modern society.

To this end, we promote high level social contributions through community-based research and education, the former of which the results we sow back into society, contributing to Hokkaido, with the aim of being a university that grows with the region.
